

## **EDITOR POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT: CALL FOR APPLICATIONS**

### **New Editor Sought for POLITICAL THEORY: AN INTERNATIONAL JOURNAL OF POLITICAL PHILOSOPHY**

Applications are invited for the position of Editor of *Political Theory: An International Journal of Political Philosophy*, published by SAGE Publications. The term of the current Editor, Mary G Dietz, will end 31<sup>st</sup> December 2012. *Political Theory* is an internationally recognized, highly rated journal, indexed in the Journal Citation Reports of Thomson Reuters. The journal is open to contributions from every theoretical and methodological perspective. Essays published in history of political thought, contemporary and continental political theory, philosophy of social science, analytical and normative political philosophy, ideological critique, and assessments of current perspectives and approaches are equally welcome. Eligible candidates for the position of Editor should have high standing in the academic political theory community, extensive familiarity with and openness to the wide array of subject matters and approaches that constitute the political theory field, and excellent communicative and organizational skills. The Editor is responsible for overseeing the appointments of the Consulting Editor, Book Review Editor, (rotating) members of the Executive Editorial Committee, and the Editorial Board. S/he is also expected to supervise the peer-review procedures, determine the final selection of articles for publication, and insure timely and substantive publication of issues of the journal.

SAGE Publications uses an integrated online electronic submission process. The new Editor will be expected to oversee and facilitate the process of digital technology and transmission, including electronic manuscript submission and peer review, and work in both online and print production modes of publication. The Editor's supporting institution normally provides office space, equipment, graduate assistantships for Assistant Editor(s) for the duration of the Editor's appointment, and release time for the Editor.

Interested applicants should submit a brief CV and letter of application to the chair of the PT Editor Selection Committee. Formal appointment of the Editor of *Political Theory* is made by SAGE Publications. The covering letter should include a statement concerning the applicant's editorial philosophy and vision for the journal, including proposals for continuing to develop its significance and visibility in the field. Applicants should also indicate their expectations concerning the availability of local institutional, administrative, and electronic support.
